





12. MEMBERSHIP OF THE TRUST:-

The membership of the trust shall be open to all irrespective of religion, caste, color sex or nationality. 15. REMOVAL FROM MEMBERSHIP:-

- (i) If a member is found guilty of gross misconduct or disservice to the trust the chairman may by a resolution to this effect, remove such a person/institution from the membership of the trust, however, such resolution of removal from member of the trust shall be passed by Author & settler / B.O.C. order only.

- The Trustees (who are the executors of this deed) may at any time after the creation of the Trust appoint one or more new Trustees. The Trustees so appointed shall have the same power, rights and status of the executing Trustees. Such induction of new Trustees shall be approved by at least 1/3rd majorities. But in any case, the number of total trustees shall not exceed to seven. In case of death, incapacitation, resignation, inability or refusal on the part of any trustees to act, as such trustee, the remaining Trustee shall be entitled to nominate any other person from his family member as they may think fit and proper to act as Trustees in the place of the Trustee so dying. Refusing to act or being unable to act.
- (b) The number of the Trustees shall not be less than three or more than eleven. If the number of the Trustee shall below two the Trustees shall not, except for the purpose of filing any vacancy, act so along number is below the said minimum.
- (c) The Trustees for the time being will be at liberty to appoint additional trustees within the number mentioned above, for such period or on such terms as to retirement and re-appointment, as the Trustee for the time being consider proper. 18. ENROLMENT AS MEMBERS:-
